What is Bioremediation?

Bioremediation is the process of using naturally occurring, safe and beneficial micro-organisms to

degrade environmentally harmful contaminants and turn them into non-toxic compounds. These organisms will break down most petroleum hydrocarbons and transform them into carbon dioxide (CO₂) and water. This natural process will produce valuable bio-nutrients that can be utilized by both plant and aquatic life. The process of Bioremediation is listed as one of the United States Environmental Protection Agency's (EPA) innovative technologies.
